EUDR Status Update

Dear Customer,

We would like to inform you that the European Parliament and the Council have now formally adopted the amended EU Deforestation Regulation (EUDR).

The amended EUDR must be published in the official EU Journal before the end of 2025, as the final formal step. This marks the end of negotiations and confirms the simplifications proposed as well as the delay of the law's application timeline.

The Key outcomes of the amended regulation are: -

One year postponement

- Large and medium operators and traders' compliance now required by 30 December 2026 (previously 30 December 2025)
- Micro and small operators' compliance now required by 30 June 2027 (previously 30 June 2026)

Due diligence obligations simplified

- Only the first company placing goods on the EU market must perform due diligence and submit a due diligence statement.
- Subsequent operators and traders are exempt from submitting due diligence statements or performing due diligence.
- Reference numbers will be passed only to the first downstream operator.

Simplified processes for SMEs

 Micro and small primary operators in low-risk countries will only need to file a one-time simplified declaration.

Further review

 The EU will review the administrative burden and simplifications by April 2026, which may lead to additional changes.

We will continue to monitor the situation and advise of any significant updates as and when they occur.
